



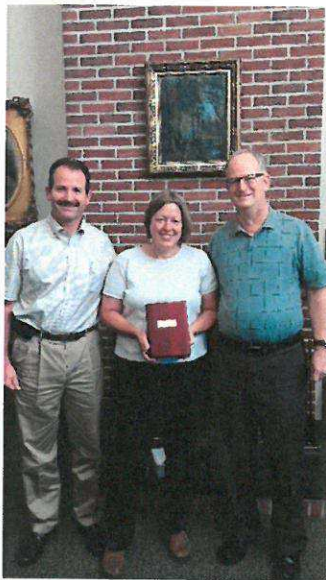

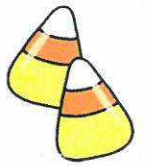
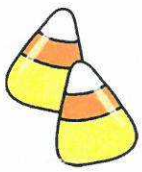

Associate of the Month

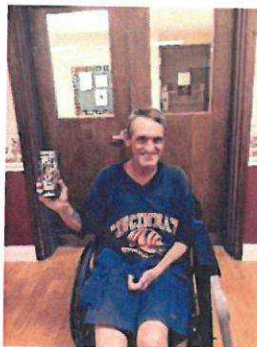
Mercedes Wright
